- (1) Research and write a glossary of:
- Common camera shot types used in filming e.g. tracking shot / Close up / establishing shot.
- Editing techniques e.g. dissolve / fade to black.

Write a definition for each and comment on the effect – where relevant E.g. Close up shots - frequently used in moments of high emotion so the audience gets a sense of the characters feelings.

(2) Choose 3-5 minutes of footage from a TV programme of your own choice and prepare a commentary explaining how camera shots and editing have been used in the extract.

Comment on:

- The effect of shots on creation of character and narrative.
- The effect of shots on the audience.
