Art Visit to the Natural History Museum, London on Thursday 26 September 2019

Year 12 A Level Art, Craft and Design students are offered the opportunity to visit the Natural History Museum in London to investigate and develop ideas from first-hand sources and to consider the context of the objects that they record. The work produced on the day will be a starting point for an investigation of the natural world and the basis for the development of ideas for the first unit of A Level coursework. Preparation for the visit will take place during lessons and the work produced, as part of the visit, will be a valuable addition to the coursework unit.

Students are asked to make a payment of £17 to cover the cost of transport by coach. Students should take a sketchbook and drawing materials with them. The coach will depart from school promptly at 8.40am and return at around 4.30pm, depending on traffic. Students are asked to take a packed lunch and a drink.
