**Visit to the Zimbardo Conference in London – Psychology
Friday 20 March 2020**

To help with understanding and appreciation for contemporary Psychology in the run up to their A Level exams, a visit has been organised to the Zimbardo Conference 2020, a yearly conference aimed towards preparing A Level students for their upcoming exams.

The event will feature a keynote speech by Philip Zimbardo, famous for his work on the Psychology of Social Influence, and the Stanford Prison Experiment, as well as a talk on effective exam technique from the event's organiser Cara Flanagan, who is also the head examiner for AQA Psychology.

Rather than arranging travel for students, we would like to invite them to make their own way into London. Your son/daughter may meet myself and Mrs Woodward at London Liverpool Street station at 9:15am, from where we will travel directly to the venue via the London Underground.

Otherwise, we are also happy to meet them at the venue itself at 10:00am, at the Emmanuel Centre on Marsham Street, which is a few minutes' walk from several Underground stations, including Westminster, Victoria and St James' Park.
